[EnviroMission Limited \(OTCQX: EVOMY\)](#) joined solar industry leaders in Arizona at the Arizona Solar Leadership Conference to develop the basis of an industry plan aimed at making Arizona a 'global powerhouse' in solar power development.

EnviroMission is developing the first 200MW Solar Tower in La Paz, Arizona and is active in the sector to promote EnviroMission's requirements as a solar developer in Arizona.

Conference participant, Arizona Senator, Michelle Reagan, Republican for Scottsdale, has been responsible for pushing several renewable energy bills through the Legislature and used the forum to restate her commitment to continue to work with the solar industry for the benefits it would also bring the to Arizona's overall economy.

Co-chair of Governor Jan Brewer's Solar Energy Task Force, Leisa Brug, told the conference the task force is looking to address three major challenges to solar: transmission, financing and permitting.

The Solar Energy Task Force is already tackling the permitting process and is focusing on ways to make it easier for projects to get through the various government agencies' processes, and is 'committed to taking it on and improving it'.

Arizona Corporation Commission Chairman (ACCC), Gary Pierce, pledged the ACCC will look at ways to get renewable technologies through the commission process as quickly as possible to keep the projects moving.

"Feedback from EnviroMission's Phoenix team about the conference's aims and objectives for the solar sector in Arizona goes a long way to justify EnviroMission's belief the decision to shift Solar Tower development to Arizona has been a positive strategic decision.

"The Arizona Government is a strong supporter of the solar renewable energy sector through policy *and* action that has already resulted in incentives and reforms to benefit businesses in the sector including EnviroMission." said EnviroMission CEO, Roger Davey.
