## EnviroMission Solar Tower Development in Arizona

[EnviroMission Limited](#) (ASX: EVM) (OTCQX: EVOMY) Executive Chairman, Roger Davey, returned to Melbourne today after leading a [Solar Tower](#) development delegation to Arizona to meet with capital finance principals and key statutory and government officials, including representatives from the Arizona State Land Department, the Arizona Corporations Commission, the Greater Phoenix Economic Council, and the City of Phoenix Community and Economic Development Department.

“EnviroMission’s *march-to-market* in Arizona received enthusiastic responses from all agencies and this support is expected to be reflected in imminent progress disclosures relating to Solar Tower site/s and associated regulatory and finance outcomes.

“Recent milestones, including the engagement of Arup to deliver executive engineering services in Arizona and the approval by the Southern California Public Power Authority to buy power from the first of EnviroMission’s 200MW Solar Tower power stations, along with EnviroMission’s move to file a notice of intent to lodge an application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility, have been achieved in parallel with integral regulatory, land and finance negotiations that are subject to non-disclosure agreements.

“I can say with confidence Solar Tower development in Arizona has stepped up a notch with site and development finance progress approaching a point for full market disclosure,” Mr. Davey said.

EnviroMission expects to announce land and finance details that will signal the start of Arup’s engineering services to deliver EnviroMission’s Solar Tower developments in Arizona.

Milestones achieved by EnviroMission in Arizona form a pathway to site specific Front End Engineering and Design for Solar Tower power station delivery:

### **Site Confirmation - Arizona**

Site confirmation informs commercial and environmental power station viability.

### **Power Purchase Agreement – Southern California Public Power Authority (SCPPA)**

Power off-take agreement confirms core revenue stream to inform commercial viability.

### **Engineering and Design Services – Arup**

Engineering services engaged for site optimized Solar Tower power station design.

### **Development Capital**

Development capital supports site acquisition and delivery of Front End Engineering and Design services.

### **Front End Engineering and Design**

Deliver of site optimized Solar Tower design - Arup has been appointed executive project engineers.

It is expected Arup will commence site specific Front End Engineering and Design immediately.

Mr. Davey did not attend EnviroMission’s 2010 AGM due to commitments in Arizona; Mr. David Galbally QC chaired the AGM in Mr. Davey’s absence.
